## Measure C and Crime in Marysville

In the most recent crime report, year-over-year crime rates in Marysville has decreased by 40.2%.

These crime rates are categorized into two primary groups: violent and property crimes. Year-over-year, violent crime has decreased by 34.8%, while property crime has decreased by 41.9%.

Overall, since the passage of Measure C, crime is down over 20% in the City of Marysville.
