NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Marysville will conduct a public hearing on November 21, 2023 at 6pm at 526 C Street, Marysville, CA 95901 in order to discuss applications for funding under the 2023 State Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program and to solicit citizen input on possible activities to be included in the application and general program review. Additionally, the City will adopt a resolution for the 2023 application at this time.

The Community Development Block Grant Program Allocation of the State CDBG program will be published in a "Notice of Funding Availability" (NOFA) each program year. The state expects to have about \$19 million available for the upcoming 2023 NOFA. Eligible cities and counties may submit applications for CDBG funds under the NOFA for a maximum per application request of up to \$3.5 million.

The proposed project for this NOFA is limited to applications submitted during the 2019 CDBG Over the Counter submittals for the following project:
