\$5,000 Offered for Leads Resulting in Arrest and Prosecution on Recent Copper Cable Thefts in Greater Marysville and Yuba City Area

- WHAT:** Vandalism of communications infrastructure is a serious matter that affects public safety and the community at large. We work with law enforcement to investigate any incidents. AT&T is offering a **reward of up to \$5,000** for information leading to the conviction of individuals responsible for a series of copper cable thefts. While the financial loss is a concern, ensuring uninterrupted and high-quality service for customers is a top priority for AT&T.
- WHERE:** The thefts have occurred in the greater Marysville and Yuba City area predominantly along roadways.
- WHEN:** The thefts started in January 2022
