

ORDINANCE NO. 1443

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARYSVILLE,
CALIFORNIA AMENDING SECTION 2.76.010 OF THE
MARYSVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE**

WHEREAS, Chapter 2.6 of the Marysville Municipal Code establishes the procedure for the purchase of goods and services for the City and for the award of contracts for Public Works contracts; and

WHEREAS, California Public Contracts Code Section 1100.7 provides that the California Public Contract Code does not apply should such code conflict with ordinances of Charter cities.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Marysville does ordain as follows:
SECTION ONE. Section 2.76.010 of the Marysville Municipal Code is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

“2.76.101 Purpose and Objectives; exemption from provisions of the California Public Contract Code.

The purpose of this Chapter is to establish efficient procedures for the purchase of goods and services for the City and for the award of Public Work Contracts at the lowest possible cost commensurate with quality needed to exercise positive financial control of purchases and to clearly define the authority for the purchasing function. The City of Marysville shall not be subject to the California Public Contract Code, in whole or in part, unless a specific provision of the Marysville Municipal Code provides for the application of the California Public Contract Code to a specific issue.”

SECTION TWO. The provisions of this ordinance shall be applied retroactively as well as prospectively.

SECTION THREE. Severability.

If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are severable. The City of Marysville hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance irrespective of the invalidity of any particular portion thereof.

SECTION FOUR. Effective Date.


This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption by the Marysville City Council.
