Discussion of Possible State CDBG Application and Review of CDBG Program

The City of Marysville anticipates submitting an application during the next CDBG program year. The City does not anticipate utilizing any CDBG Program Income for this upcoming application/project.

The purpose of this meeting/hearing is to review CDBG eligible activities and collect residents' views on housing and community development needs (which includes services, facilities, and/or infrastructure that will improve livability within the community). Light refreshments will be provided.
