## DETACHED SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL SMOKE DETECTORS AND CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS SELF-CERTIFICATION AFFIDAVIT

Per California state law effective January 1, 2011, when building permits are issued for additions, alterations or repairs to residential buildings and the value of the work exceeds \$1,000, smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors must be installed per code for the safety of the occupants, if these detectors have not already been installed.

- Smoke detectors shall be installed in each sleeping room, outside each separate sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of the bedrooms, and on each additional story of the dwelling, including basements and habitable attics as required by Section R314.6 of the 2010 California Residential Code (CRC), Section 420.4 and 907.2.11.2 of the 2010 California Building Code (CBC), and Section 13113.7 of the California Health & Safety Code.
- For dwellings or sleeping units containing fuel burning appliances or having attached garages, carbon monoxide detectors shall be installed outside each separate sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of the bedrooms, and on each additional story of the dwelling, including basements, as required by CRC Section R315.2 and CBC Section 420.4.
- Multipurpose (combination carbon monoxide and smoke) alarms may be used per CRC Section R315.1.5 and CBC 420.4.1.5.
- All alarms shall comply with requirements for listing and approval by the Office of the State Fire Marshall. [http://osfm.fire.ca.gov/licensinglistings/licenselisting\\_bml\\_searchcotest.php](http://osfm.fire.ca.gov/licensinglistings/licenselisting_bml_searchcotest.php)

These safety devices must be installed by the time a final inspection is requested for your project, and this Self-Certification Affidavit must be returned to the City of Marysville Inspector prior to final sign-off of all building permits requiring compliance. The smoke and carbon monoxide detectors must be installed in accordance with the manufacturer's written instructions and can be battery operated in areas where no construction is taking place.

NOTE: This Self-Certification Affidavit is *only* applicable when normal access to the interior of a detached single-family residential dwelling by the City of Marysville Building Inspector is not required during the course of project construction, such as re-roofing, re-siding, adding attached patio covers, decks, swimming pools, and similar exterior projects. When the project involved the interior of the house, or a building other than a detached single-family residence, inspection of the smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors by the City Building Inspector will be required prior to the final approval of your project, and an adult must be present at the time of the inspection.

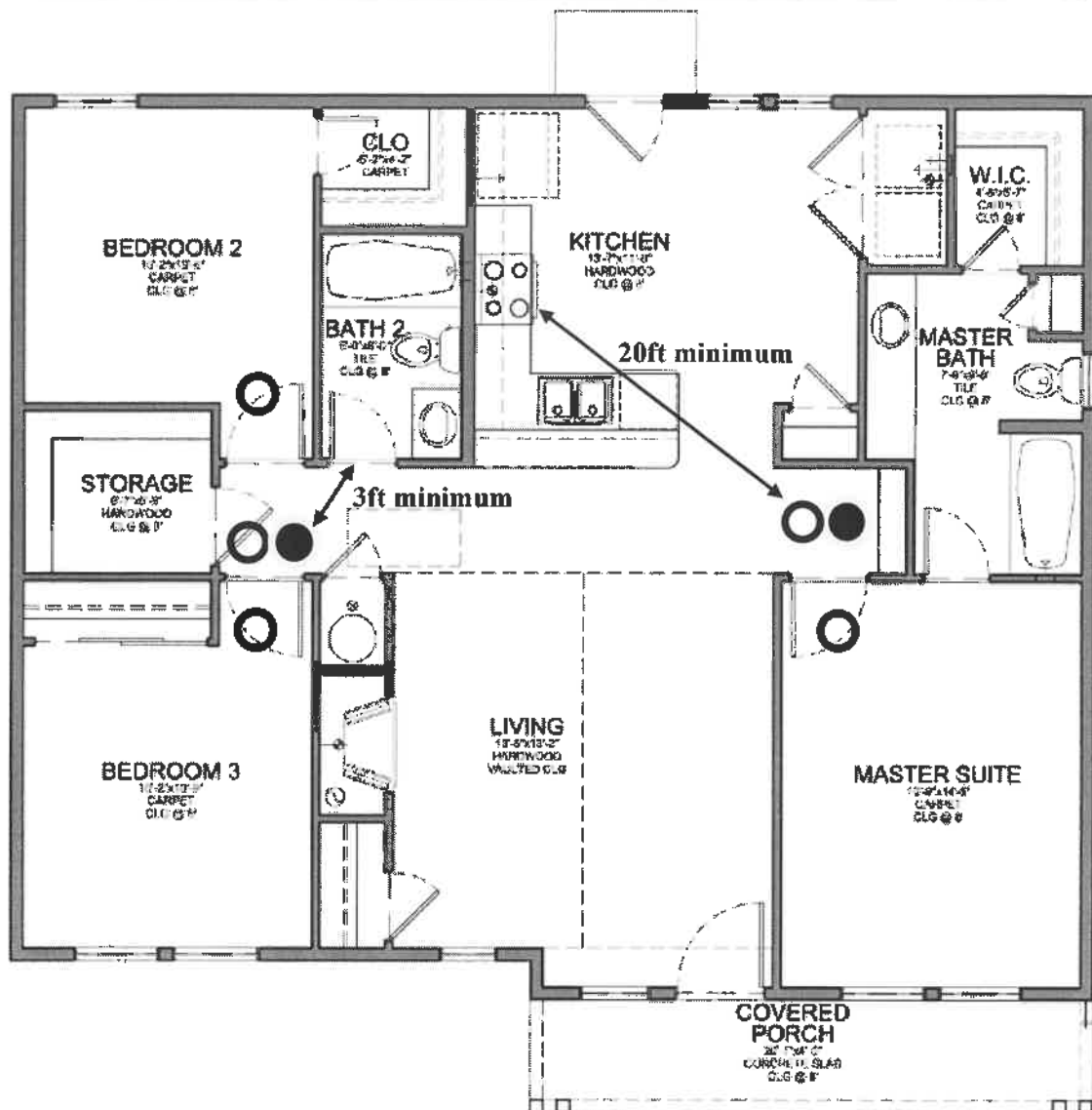

## Required Locations of Smoke/Carbon Monoxide Detectors



○ = Smoke Detector

● = Carbon Monoxide Detector

*(Combination Smoke/Carbon Monoxide detectors are recommended)*

### Placement Considerations:

- Remember that every level including basements also requires both carbon monoxide and smoke detectors
- Smoke detectors shall have a minimum **10-year** rated battery (*effective July 1, 2014*)
- Detectors shall be located a minimum of **20ft away** from cooking appliances
- Detectors shall be located **three (3) feet away** from openings into bathrooms, mechanical supply/return registers and ceiling fans
